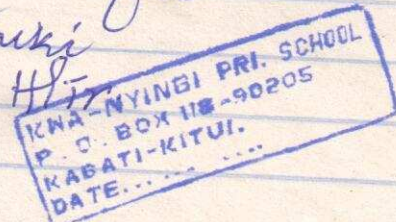

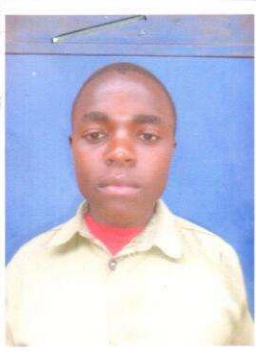

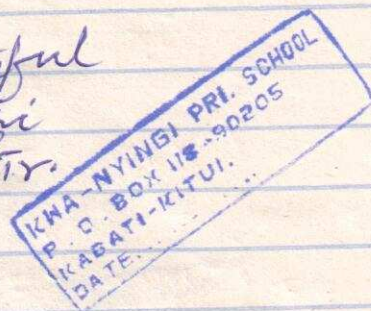

She stayed in Narok from 2008 to early 2009. When she come back to Molo, her health had deteriorated. She was on and off hospital though she worked. In April the year 2010, she was admitted at Molo District hospital where she stayed for two months and then passed on.

She left us in rental premises - I and my two brothers. I am the second born son. My elder brother is Peter Kainaina and my younger brother is Richard Kimani. We were left under the care of our grandmother who is a drunkard and also would lack food and other needs for us. She could not go to work due to drunkenness.

I could not stand staying with her because she is too old and she could not manage to take care for us. I left my younger brother there and come to join my older brother who is a student

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at Molo secondary school. My elder brother who is in form four advised me to ^{repeat} instead of wasting time at home, though with little hope I made up my mind to repeat.

My younger brother who ~~had~~ ^{repeated} done his k.c.p.e last year also ^{repeated} due to lack of school fees. He managed to score 286 in the k.c.p.e. He opted to stay with my great grandmother in Subukia. The two of us are candidates this year. We are expecting good marks but little hope of joining high schools due to lack of school fees.

My elder brother who is in form four has been assisted by his primary school teachers up to the far he has reached. I and my elder brother we are living in the church. Despite of that, I have not given up in life. I ^{am} determined to reach the height of education. I therefore kindly request ^{sponsorship} to enable me realize my dream of becoming an engineer. God bless you as you plan to help me.



I am the first born in a family of three children. The other two are boys - one in class five and the other one in class two. I am a single-parented child. I became so after the separation between my mum and dad in the year 2006.

Before the separation, my parents were always quarrelling and fighting. I can remember very well how my father used to hate and mistreat me, claiming that I was not his child. After the separation, I, my mum and my two brothers decided to move away from my father's home. We moved to Molo (Muchorwi) where my grandmother lived. It seemed like we were all under the care of my poor, aged grandmother.

My grandmother was not very fortunate since she had no land of her own. She leases farms. She also stays in a rented house where we had to squeeze to fit in. Later, my mother started working as a manual labourer. She used to save some money - regardless of the

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amount which finally enabled us to move to molo town to start a new life. I stayed at home for one month giving my mother time to look for a job and provide money to take us to school. She found none. Instead, she decided to work as a casual worker to provide for us since she had to get for our food, clothing and everything we needed.

I've forgotten that I had a father as he also forgot that he had children. Sometimes we are sent home due to lack of money needed in school. We have no otherwise than to stay at home until my mum gets the money. This does not make me despair because I am ambitious to pass well and join my favourite secondary school. I am confident and determined that I will pass and attain my beautiful goals and dreams.

I am kindly asking for assistance to carry on with my education. Your assistance will be highly appreciated and I will be grateful if you consider my case.
