at Molo secondary school. My elder brother who is in form four advised me to <sup>repeat</sup> instead of wasting time at home, though with little hope I made up my mind to repeat.

My younger brother who ~~had~~ <sup>repeated</sup> done his K.C.P.E last year also due to lack of school fees. He managed to score 286 in the K.C.P.E. He opted to stay with my great grandmother in Subukia. The two of us are candidates this year. We are expecting good marks but little hope of joining high school due to lack of school fees.

My elder brother who is in form four has been assisted by his primary school teachers up to the far he has reached. I and my elder brother we are living in the church. Despite of that, I have not given up in life. I <sup>am</sup> determined to reach the height of education. I therefore kindly request <sup>sponsorship</sup> to enable me realize my dream of becoming an engineer. God bless you as you plan to help me.
