After the separation, my mum and my two brothers decided to move away from my father's home. We moved to Molo (Muchorwi) where my grandmother lived. It seemed like we were all under the care of my poor, aged grandmother.

My grandmother was not very fortunate since she had no land of her own. She leases farms. She also stays in a rented house where we had to squeeze to fit in. Later, my mother started working as a manual labourer. She used to save some money - regardless of the

She found none. Instead, she decided to work as a casual worker to provide for us since she had to fetch for our food, clothing and everything we needed.

I've forgotten that I had a father as he also forgot that he had children. Sometimes we are sent home due to lack of money needed in school. We have no other choice than to stay at home

until my mum gets the money. This does not make me despair because I am ambitious to pass well and join my favourite Secondary School. I am confident and determined that I will pass and attain my beautiful goals and dreams.

I am kindly asking for assistance to carry on with my education. Your assistance will be highly appreciated and I will be grateful if you consider my request.
