In my family I am the eighth born among eleven children. I am a boy aged sixteen years old. Our first born is a casual labourer. He stays in Kuresoi. The second born is a watchman in Nairobi. The third one is a casual labourer who stays in Timbora. The fourth one is married and the fifth one was employed this year. The sixth and the seventh are students. I have other one brother and two sisters in Kambala.

My Parents are casual labourers. They sometimes work in a condition that sometimes leads to diseases. My parents are unable to satisfy our basic needs such as clothing, food and even sometimes shelter. We sometimes go to school with worn out uniforms. We even go to school with shoes that cannot prevent anything even if it is harmful. We live in a rental house

It is in a very bad conditions. When there is prolonged rainy season, our house leaks and becomes muddy. My brother is now at home because he lack secondary school fees. My elder sister left school because every time she was being sent home to bring the money.

When my parents go to work, they use the money to buy us food. Every time we are sent home to bring the money. The parents are unable to pay all the money with that little wage. Sometimes I stay at home for almost two weeks. Then I am given little amount of money to take to school.

My request is that you please assist me with school fees and I promise to utilize every opportunity given to me well. I will be grateful if you will accept my request.
