**SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS**NB: All students **MUST** observe and follow all school rules and regulations.

Students are expected to embrace discipline and hard work if they are to become better citizens at the end of their course. Therefore the following rules must be adhered to:

**1. Class attendance**All lessons and prep sessions **MUST** be attended. If a student must miss prep/lessons, then the office must have authorized his/her absence.**2. Uniform**All students must have the proper full school uniform, everyday between 5.00a.m and 9.30pm. This uniform must be purchased from Shah Outfitters, wool shop, Bookmart(K) Ltd and Ereto Bookshop in Nakuru. **All items must be labeled for easy identification.** At night between 9.30pm and 5.00 am, the student is expected to put on a nightdress (girls) or pyjama (boys). Civilian clothing of whatever kind are confiscated and never returned.**3. Personal appearance.**

Hair – Must always be kept tidy for both boys and girls. Boys shall be expected to shave every 3 weeks. Both boys and girls are not allowed to apply chemical relaxers on their hair. Disallowed hairdo will be shaved.

- Use of nail varnish, lipstick, perfumes, bangles, necklaces are prohibited. If the same are found, they are confiscated and student punished accordingly.

#### **4. Food stuff/meals**

The school provides enough food and a balanced diet. Students are not allowed to bring foodstuffs of any kind into the compound, including sweets and confectionary. Any student found to be culpable he/she will be made to purchase same stuff for a whole class.

NB: The school does not provide any special diet.

#### **5. Mid term break**

The school has mid-term breaks each term to enable students meet their parents/ buy what they need. **Visiting of students is not allowed** without prior permission from the office. Any student flouting the same will be excluded for two weeks.

#### **6. Sickness**

The school has a medical facility that provides only first aid. Sick students are permitted to visit Rongai Health Centre accompanied by the matron or a member of staff. Students who have health problems should come with letters from Public health institutions so that the school may know how to assist them when they are in need. No students are allowed to sleep in the hostels while sick unless with permission from the office. Flouting the same is punishable.

#### **7. School property**

Students **MUST** take care of school property to avoid damages or breakages. Any deliberate breakages will result to the student replacing the property twice in quantity.

8. Students are not allowed to have any electronic gadgets e.g. Radios, T.V sets/phones, computers, modems if any, they are confiscated never to be returned. Only the school phone is accessible for use in communication while in school.

9. students must not engage in any form of indiscipline e.g. theft, coupling i.e. boy/girl relationships, sneaking out of school, fighting, bullying, being in possession of drugs/ alcohol, cigarettes, abusing others, immoral behaviour, disobedient, disrespect, gossip, being in possession of pornographic materials, tribal groupings, religious discrimination, hate speech. culpable a student will be excluded for two weeks upon facing the disciplinary committee.

10. The school farm, teachers quarters and workers quarters are out of bounds to all students. Boys are not allowed to visit the girl's dormitory just as girls are not allowed to visit the boy's dormitory. Failure to adhere to this rule may attract exclusion or disciplinary action or both.

**11. School programmes** - Prolonged absence from school for a period exceeding one week will result into disciplinary action being taken against such a student and that includes expulsion.

12. Students sent home to bring parents and end up bringing imposters will automatically be expelled.

13. Students who hung around Salgaa, Rongai centres and Nakuru town during the half-term breaks, holidays and any other time will have disciplinary action taken against them or excluded for two weeks.

14. Students found making noise in the dormitory after ten in the night will be subjected to instant disciplinary action.

15. Students should respect teachers and avoid confrontation of whatever sort. Responding rudely to teachers or throwing words at teachers will result to suspension and by extension expulsion.


