The two of us are candidates this year. We are expecting good marks but little hope of joining high schools due to lack of school fees.

My elder brother who is in form four has been assisted by his primary school teachers up to the far he has reached. I and my elder brother we are living in the church. Despite of that, I have not given up in life. I am determined to reach the height of Education. I therefore kindly request sponsorship to enable me realize my dream of becoming an engineer.
