

She was treated at Borangi Dispensary and also went to Nyamache district hospital for a month but she never got any improvement. She was referred to Kisii General Hospital, where she was admitted for about two months and then discharged though not in good condition. Her condition deteriorated and she was taken back to hospital. She was diagnosed of being HIV positive. This hastened her death. My father resorted to drinking. After realising that she was HIV positive. He passed on later in August the year 2008.

We were left orphans, my three siblings and I. We underwent difficult times. We were considered an omen; called all the bad names. Let alone being subjected to hard work. Going to school became historical. I was forced by my uncle to drop out of school in class five to work for my stomach. My elder sister ran away from home, and got married and the other has disappeared to date. Her whereabouts are not known. My younger brother and I stayed with my uncle.

In the year 2010 we decided to escape from home with my brother. We had worked for a neighbour who paid us Sh. 500. I decided to escape due to suffering. We travelled to Molo to live with my aunt. My aunt is a house wife. Married as a second wife with partial orphans (children of her late co-wife to take care). My chances of joining

High school is narrow. She has no income of her own to sponsor me.

From 2010 when I was Standard five we have lived with her to date. I am in class eight and my younger brother is Standard six the same school. I am awaiting for Kenya Certificate of Primary Education examination with very little hope of joining a secondary school. I aspire to be a pilot. With your assistance I know I will make it.
